With growing mobility, noise pollution due to transport has become a real problem seriously affecting human health. Impacts are numerous, ranging from cardiovascular disease, sleep disturbance to psychological problems. According to the World Health Organisation (WHO), traffic-related noise may account for 1 million healthy years of life lost each year in Western Europe. Addressing the problem of noise pollution in transport is essential to preserve health and quality of life. Well aware of this problem, the European Commission released in December 2011 a proposal aiming to regulate the sound level of motor vehicles.

In the presence of MEP Miroslav Ouzky (ECR, Czech Republic), Rapporteur on the Commission's proposal (ENVI Committee), this event will seek to contribute to the ongoing discussion by shaping the legal and practical tools for reducing decibels in road transport.
